MACHINED/CUT - Panels or boards that have been molded, cut to size, perforated, or further machined to add groves and rabbets.

COATED/LAMINATED FINISH - Panels or boards that are face finished on one or both surfaces by printing or by the addition of fillers, sealers, waxes, oils, stains, varnishes, paints, enamels, and/or similar materials or have been overlaid or laminated with nonwood materials including vinyl.
